We request that payments be made <u>online</u>, using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. Student statement of accounts and/or payment requests will be sent directly to parents via email and will include a unique link to make secure payment online through the Westpac Parent Online Payment system. Payments can also be made by cash or cheque to the school office.

Please return the **Payment Requirements** sheet and **Consent Form** (if required) to the school with payment, including a receipt number if payment has been made online. Please ensure your child's full name and class are inserted on **each sheet**.
